Free universal entitlement is available at a maximum of 3 hrs per day 8.30 - 11.30 to all children from the term following their 3rd birthday up to the term in which the child turns 5.

The universal entitlement is a maximum of 15 hours per week for 38 weeks of the year, regardless of parental income.

Parents who do not use their full 15 hours per week may claim the remaining hours through another registered provider. Any extended hours entitlement may also be claimed through another registered provider.
