#### **Breakfast Club (Daily from 7.30am)**

£6.00 per day when booked in one half term in advance.

#### **After School Provision (until 6.30pm)**

£17.30 per day when booked one whole term in advance

School fees are invoiced termly in advance and fees for Breakfast Club, After School Provision and all other extras are charged a term in arrears. Childcare vouchers are accepted for Nursery, Breakfast Club, our After School Provision and our holiday club.

A non-refundable Registration Fee of (£150\* for Nursery and £180 for Reception-Form 6) is charged per child and should accompany the Registration Form. An Acceptance Fee of £1,000 per child is payable on formal acceptance of a place. This is refundable when the child leaves the School.

As all school fees are due on the first day of term, interest of 2% per month is charged on all overdue accounts. In addition, any fees unpaid three months after the due date will attract a further administration charge equivalent to 10% of the unpaid account. The Governing Body is anxious to stress that they should be contacted at once in cases of exceptional circumstances.

At least one full term's notice, in writing, is required if your child is to be withdrawn, and in lieu of such notice, one full term's fees will be immediately payable as debt.

We reserve the right to make additional charges for reimbursement of expenses incurred for items not customarily included within our school fee charges.

Fees are subject to annual review.
